



FIELD TRIPS TO THE FARM

General Information

- A minimum of 20 children will be required to schedule a field trip experience.
- There is an \$9 admission fee per child (Includes free field trip pumpkin)
- Free admission for required teachers/staff. 1 teacher/staff member is required per 10 children. ALL ADDITIONAL STAFF, PARENTS & SIBLINGS (ages 2 & up) MUST PAY REGULAR FIELD TRIP ADMISSION COST. ONLY STUDENT WILL RECEIVE FREE PUMPKIN.
- Field Trips will be scheduled in 2-hr increments. A minimum 2-week notice is necessary to schedule. Please notify us of any special needs at the time of scheduling.

- Sack lunch is required.
- Bathrooms available on site.

Field Trip Itinerary

- Please have payment ready and arrive no later than 10 minutes early to speed up the admission process and not delay time on the farm! We prefer one form of payment to settle admission cost & accept cash, all major credit cards, & school checks.
- If late to the tour, time will not be extended and train ride and classroom session may be forfeited due to time constraints.
- We will start with a 5-10 minute short educational segment.
- Next, staff and children are allowed to explore the farm at their own pace! Activities include:
 - Navigate through our 5-acre sorghum maze, participating in our maze scavenger hunt along the way
 - Discover & play throughout our 2-acres of fall fun games (some attractions will not be available during field trips)
- At the end of the experience, children will be allowed to pick one small field trip pumpkin (included in admission cost). Sack lunches may be enjoyed at this time as well.
- In the event of light rain & scattered showers, we can provide classroom education & a modified tour. If the weather is severe, we will first try to reschedule. If rescheduling is not an option, we will dispense one free admission ticket to each child to use at his/her own convenience throughout our season of operation.

What to Wear

Please instruct children to wear appropriate seasonal clothing that will be comfortable for outdoor play. Closed-toe walking shoes are also recommended. Be prepared to get a little dirty as you explore the farm!

What to Bring

- Water Bottle
- Sack Lunch
- Medical Supplies (i.e. antihistamine, EpiPen, and/or asthma inhalers) for those with allergies to an outdoor environment.
